### Let's get to know each other....deeply!

*Thoughts for the month of September by Pastor Allan*

Have I told you how excited I am to be in your midst?! Each and every day our family is feeling more and more comfortable about being a part of the fellowship! While we've only been here a few short weeks, we feel like we are already getting to know you! First I want to thank you for your grace and understanding regarding my limitations of "name recognition"! Recently a couple from the Church had our family over to their home for a yummy dinner and a chance to get to know each other. We love invitations to

come into your home to discover who you are in a more personal way!

I really enjoyed the fellowship opportunities that we had at the pavilion in recent weeks! First the food that everyone brought and our team prepared was incredible. I got a sense just from the wonderful food that everyone prepared that we are a people who deeply love the Lord and one another, and we want to bring our very best to the table! It's not that I was expecting crab-legs and caviar at our meals; it's the care that seemed to come along with each dish that impressed me! Last week I had the opportunity to lead the *Hymn-Sing!* I invited a good friend and keyboardist Dr. Frank Novasack Jr. to participate with me. We had such a fun time singing songs like "*The Old Rugged Cross*", "*What a friend we have in Jesus*" and "*I'll Fly away.*" In between songs my three year old son Aaron treated us to more popular songs like "Cheeseburgers in Paradise!" This past Saturday morning I attended the *Men's Bible Study* which meets weekly in the fellowship hall. I arrived around 7:50 am and enjoyed a hot cup of tea and a fresh donut that Brother Larry brought! ## **PLUM CREEK'S FALL FESTIVAL IS COMING**


